Senior Trip Contract and Expectations

Your child's senior trip is fast approaching. We want as many students as possible to attend the Overbrook High School Senior Trip to Orlando, Florida; however we would like to make a few expectations very clear before your child decides to sign up:

Financial Contract

1. The final cost of the 2018 senior class trip is **\$1,500**;
2. In order to secure your child's spot on the senior trip, we will need a \$1,000 deposit by September of your child's senior year – no exceptions;
3. Your money is only fully refundable until September of your child's senior year. After that, you will be subject to fines and penalties to be determined by the travel agency;
4. As per Pine Hill District policy, if your child accrues 3 suspensions (in/out of school) throughout his/her senior year, they will no longer be eligible for the senior trip. If this 3rd suspension takes place after September of your child's senior year, you will not receive a full refund and could possibly have to pay a fine as a result of the cancellation;

Student Expectations

- Students are expected to exhibit a level of maturity, independence, and responsibility while on the trip. Chaperones are in every park with the students in case of emergencies, but will not follow students around to every ride and attraction;
- The Senior Trip is by no means a relaxing vacation and can be very physically demanding. With the cost of the trip being very high, we wake up early, take students to every park, and keep them at the parks until about 10pm every night. Many students walk up to 10 miles a day around the parks. The Florida sun is also very strong. Students are expected to be mindful of both of these while on the trip;
- Under no circumstance will a student be permitted to remain at the hotel unsupervised (i.e. because of fatigue, sunburn, physical soreness, etc.). If there is a medical emergency, students will be taken to Urgent Care, the Emergency Room, or sent home.

We do not want to deter any student from attending the senior class trip; we only want to make sure students are aware of their responsibilities while on the trip.
